Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I respectfully request your consideration for the Fiscal Year 2027 funding in the amount of \$20,000,000 for The City of Palm Coast to convert Wastewater Treatment Plant No. 1 (WWTP1) to Advanced Wastewater Treatment (AWT) standards as a community project funding request. The intended recipient is The City of Palm Coast, located at 160 Lake Avenue, Palm Coast FL 32164.

The project would be valuable to use taxpayer funds because Wastewater Treatment Plant No. 1 serves a significant portion of Palm Coast's residential and commercial population and upgrading the facility will enhance environmental protection for local waterways, support continued population growth, and ensure long-term resiliency of critical wastewater infrastructure.

This project has a federal nexus because the requested funding is consistent with the purposes authorized under Section 603 of The Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. #1383), including Section 603(c), which allows federal assistance for wastewater infrastructure projects that protect water quality through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program.
